2 27-07-2019 After some argument learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to file an appropriate appeal before the District Magistrate East Champaran, Motihari in terms of Clause 32 of the Bihar Targeted P.D.S. (Control) Order 2016.

In the given facts and circumstances of the case, the writ application is being disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate appeal before the District



Magistrate, East Champaran, Motihari within a period of 30 days from today.

If such an appeal is preferred within the prescribed period the same shall be considered on its own merit and will be disposed of with reasoned order within the statutory period.

In case any question of limitation arises, the same shall be considered keeping in mind that the petitioner was pursuing his remedy before this Court.
