3 20-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Turkauliya (Raghunathpur) P.S. Case No. 247 of 2019 for
the offences under Sections 413 and 414/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in
the present case. It is further submitted that nothing has been
recovered from his possession and he has no concerned with the
alleged seized vehicles. There is no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case,
let the above named, petitioner be released on bail, in the event



of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate East Champaran, at Motihari in connection with Turkauliya (Raghunathpur) P.S. Case No. 247 of 2019 subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
