The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code and 27 of the Arms Act.

The prosecution case, in short, is that while the informant was cooking vegetable in her house, the accused persons entered her house and gave knife blow and also made firing.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 14-04-2019. Charge sheet has already been submitted. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. The injury report, annexed as



Annexure-2 to the present application, does not indicate as to whether any of the injury is grievous or simple. It cannot be ascertained whether offence under section 307 of the Indian Penal Code is made out or not.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sheohar in connection with Shyampur Bhataha P.S. Case No. 39 of 2019.
