The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the offences under Sections 25(1-b)a and 26 of the Arms Act.

Prosecution case, in short, is that one loaded country made pistol and one live cartridge are recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 13.2.2019. Charge-sheet has been submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. It is alleged that one loaded country made pistol and one live cartridge are recovered. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the



petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances,
it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on
bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with
two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of
learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Munger in connection with
Kasim Bazar P.S. Case No. 34 of 2019.
