ORAL ORDER

2 04-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends her arrest for the offences alleged under Sections 147, 148, 149, 188, 341, 342, 323, 324, 326, 325, 307, 332, 333, 337, 338, 353, 427, 449, 450, 451, 452, 461 and 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 and 4 of Damage of Public Property Act registered in connection with Buddha Colony P.S. Case No. 436 of 2018.

3. It is submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated and the F.I.R. has been instituted against as many as 167 named and 300-350 unknown persons in connection with a mob of trainee constables including the petitioner having attacked and assaulted to police officials upon death of a female trainee constable during her treatment. It is submitted that no specific overt act has been attributed to the petitioner. Similarly situated co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail by this Court (Annexure-2 series). Statement is made at the Bar



that the petitioner is accused in one prior case of similar nature which has arisen from the same occurrence.

4. Be that as it may, in the event of the petitioner's arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Judge-XVI cum ACJM, Patna, in connection with Buddha Colony P.S. Case No. 436 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C., and also subject to the following further conditions -

(i) That one of the bailors shall be a close relative of the petitioner.

(ii) That the petitioner shall not indulge in any similar offence till conclusion of the trial.

(iii) That the petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation, if not already concluded, and make herself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the State shall be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.

(iv) That the petitioner shall be well represented in Court on each and every date during trial except as and when directed by the learned Court below to be physically present, and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, her bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled by the learned Court concerned.
