3 05-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are in custody since 06.07.2019 in connection with Pipra P.S. Case No. 71 of 2019, Special Case No. 5934 of 2019, registered for the offence under Section 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the alleged recoveries were not made from the conscious possession of the petitioners but from a motorcycle which does not belong to the petitioners. It is further submitted that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforementioned facts and



circumstances and that the petitioners have clean antecedents, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise, Patna, in connection with Pipra P.S. Case No.71 of 2019, Special Case No. 5934 of 2019.
