ORAL ORDER

2 03-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Maner P.S. Case no. 158 of 2019, registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 341, 448, 379, 504 & 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code Section 27 of the Arms Act.

The accusation is that informant had planted Parwal (pointed guard) at the bank of river Ganga, where some



persons were prepared country made liquor of that side and after getting such information, Police personnel came there and destroyed the liquor Bhatti. Thereafter, on 30.03.2019, eleven persons named in the F.I.R., including the petitioners, came at the house of informant and started abusing the informant and told that he had called the Police and destroyed the liquor Bhatti. Thereafter, they entered into the house of informant, at that time, Bir Bahadur Rai snatched golden chain worth of Rs. 60,000/- other persons started pelting stones and made firing in which Randhir Rai and Anil Rai, family members of the informant, sustained injuries. Thereafter, all persons fled away giving threatening to destroy the Parwal, if informant will not give ransom of Rs. 10,000/- per month.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners and informant are co-villagers and the field of informant is adjacent to the field of petitioners due to that reasons the petitioner have been made accused. Further submission is that petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail



bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Danapur in connection with Maner P.S. Case No. 158 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
