2 05-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are in custody since 25.07.2019 in connection with Town P.S. Case No.256 of 2019 registered for the offence Sections 30(A), 37(b) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that only because the police suspected that the petitioners are alleged to have taken liquor and with certain recoveries from the motorcycle, the petitioners were taken into custody. It is further submitted that the petitioners were arrested on mere conjectures and surmises.



Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-VII-Cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Aurangabad, in connection with Town P.S. Case No.256 of 2019.
