3 20-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Bariyarpur P.S. Case No. 66 of 2009 (G.R. No. 1359 of
2009), registered under Sections 467, 468, 469, 409, 406 and
420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case. Further submission is that the
petitioner is not named in the FIR and there is no
material/evidence in the case diary against the petitioner. The
petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the above facts and circumstances
of the case, let the above-named petitioner be released on bail,



in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-II, Munger in connection with Bariyarpur P.S. Case No. 66 of 2009 (G.R. No. 1359 of 2009) subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
