3 20-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Dariyapur P.S. Case No. 274 of 2014 for the offence
punishable under Sections 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that the petitioner is innocent and has not
committed any offence. In fact, the name of this petitioner
has surfaced in this case on the basis of confessional
statement of the co-accused, Rajesh Mahto and except
confession, nothing is on record against the petitioner.
Hence, the petitioner may be granted the privilege of
anticipatory bail.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the, above named, petitioners in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.-IV, Saran at Chapra in connection with Dariyapur P.S. Case No. 274 of 2014 subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
