ORAL ORDER

2 09-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 272, 273/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

12.9 litres of Nepali liquor was recovered from possession of two persons including the petitioner. Petitioner has got no such type of criminal antecedent. Petitioner is in custody since 04.07.2019.

Considering the facts aforesaid, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail, **after completion of investigation of the case against the petitioner**, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two



sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Sikty Police Station Case No. 98 of 2019 corresponding to Special Case No. 854 of 2019, subject to the following conditions:-

(a) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the learned court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(b) Both the bailors shall be resident of the territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.
