APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offences under Sections 401 and 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution allegation, in short, is that two mobile
phones have been recovered from the accused persons.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 19.4.2019. Charge-
sheet/prosecution report has been submitted in this case. There
is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the
petitioner. Two mobile phones in question are alleged to have
been recovered belong to the petitioner. The petitioner has
been made accused due to mistake of fact.



On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Rail Sonpur, Saran in connection with Muzaffarpur P.S. Case No. 86 of 2019, G.R. No. 115 of 2019.
