2 26-08-2019 Having heard Ms. Anusri, who prays for an adjournment, we are not inclined to grant the same keeping in view the facts of the present case where all the three petitioners are accused in a criminal case where the allegations against them are of having committed an offence under Section 304B read with Section 120B of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act. Their bail applications appeared to have been rejected on 26th of June,



2019 and 25th of July, 2019 by the courts below. In the aforesaid background, we do not find it necessary to entertain submissions with regard to the confinement which is alleged to be unlawful without any remand order.

Once the bail application has been rejected, it is open to the petitioners to approach for the higher court with regard to same. For the reason aforesaid, we do not entertain this application at this stage. It is accordingly rejected.
