The matter is, accordingly, taken up for consideration as both parties are present and willing to assist the court for disposal of the matter.

It is agreed between the parties that complaint filed by the petitioner before the District Programme Officer, Samastipur (Annexure 7) is still pending.

Petitioner has assailed selection of respondent no.9 as Anganbari Sevika of Center no. 185 under Khanpur Block, Samastipur.

Since petitioner has approached appropriate forum under the guidelines, it is agreed that writ petition may be disposed off with a direction to the District Programme Officer, Samastipur (Respondent no.4) to take final decision on petitioner's application.
