APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Section 394 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that four unknown miscreants assaulted
the informant and his newphew by danda, due to which they
received injuries in their head and they also snatched
informant's golden chain and Rs.50,000/- cash.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 26.06.2019. Charge sheet has
been submitted in the case. There is no allegation of tampering
of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is not
named in the F.I.R. His name has come on confessional
statement of co-accused. There is no recovery of any



incriminating article from the possession of the petitioner.

Petitioner has not been put on T.I.P.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Sherghati, Gaya in connection with Sherghati P.S. case No.282 of 2015.
