ORAL ORDER

2 16-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are in custody since 22.07.2019 in connection with Dhanarua P.S. Case No.296 of 2019 (Special Case No.6514 of 2019) registered for the offence under Section 30(A) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of the petitioners but from Sitachak More. It is further submitted that petitioner nos.1 and 2 are having no criminal antecedents and petitioner no.3 is involved in three other cases, in which he



has already been extended the privilege of bail.

Considering that the alleged recoveries were not from their conscious possession, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise, Patna, in connection with Dhanarua P.S. Case No.296 of 2019 (Special Case No.6514 of 2019).
