Mr. Mohit Shrivastava, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this is the second anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of the petitioner in connection with Bihar P.S.Case No. 496 of 2018 registered under Section 30 and 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.
