Counsel for the petitioner is permitted to implead the
Director General of Police, Bihar, Patna (for short 'DGP') as
respondent no. 4.

Counsel for the petitioner after some arguments, and
realising his difficulty arising out of non-availing of the
statutory departmental alternative remedy submits that he will
be filing his memorial before the DGP within a period of two
weeks from today. In the event such memorial is filed the
respondent no. 4 would be obliged to consider the petitioner's
memorial on its own merit without raising the issue of his
memorial being barred or preferred after a delay having regard
to the fact that the petitioner has spent time for availing his



remedy before this Court. Let the final decision be taken by the respondent no. 4 within a period of eight weeks in case the memorial is preferred within two weeks from today alongwith a copy of this order.

Writ petition is disposed off.
