has prayed for following relief(s):-

“That this application is being filed by way of Public Interest Litigation on behalf of the petitioner above named for issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus Commanding and directing the respondent authority to not transfer the Rajkiy Aurbedic Center Benar bearing Center No. 125 to Samudayic Health Centre Sermera in pursuant to letter No. 283 dated 22.2.2019 issued Under the Signature of respondent Additional Secretary because if the Rajkiy Aurbedic Ausdhalay Benar would be shifted to Sermera then it will be shifted for more than 20 kilometer from Benar and in such position the



people in general of Benar Area would be compelled to face so many difficulties for their treatment

Further for issuance of any other writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions for which petitioner shall be found entitled Under the facts and circumstances of the case under principle of equitable Justice.”

None appears on behalf of the petitioner, however, learned counsel for the respondents is present.

The instant writ application stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
