learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 22.07.2019 in connection with G.O. Case No.423 of 2019 arising out of Keoti P.S. Case No.61 of 2019 registered for the offence under Sections 30(a), 38(1), 41(1) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged recoveries were from the *Bhuskar* of the petitioner and not from his conscious possession.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances and that the petitioner has no criminal antecedents, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand)



with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of
the learned Additional District Judge IInd cum Special Judge,
