ORAL ORDER

2 07-01-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Petitioner, who is in custody, seeks bail in
connection with Special Case No. 10030 of 2018 arising out of
Bypass P.S. Case No. 333 of 2018 registered for the offence
punishable under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition &
Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation is of recovery of 100 litres of country
made Mahua wine and 1.2 litres in pouch of Mahua wine
prepared in the house of co-accused Gorush Mahto. Allegation
against petitioner and other co-accused is of being present there.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
20.10.2018.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, Patna, in connection with Special Case No. 10030 of 2018 arising out of Bypass P.S. Case No. 333 of 2018 subject to the conditions that:-

(1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.

(2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be represented on each and every date fixed by the court.

(3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.

(4) If the petitioner is found involved in similar nature of offences, after his release on bail the trial court shall take steps to cancel his bail bond.
