2 01-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 52 of 2019 for the offences under Sections 399, 402, 414 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25(1-b)a, 26, 35 of Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 24.01.2019. He further submits that after investigation police has submitted charge sheet under section 414 I.P.C. and 25(1-b)a, 26, 35 of Arms Act.

Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal antecedent and petitioner has remained in custody for more than



eight months, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, let the petitioner, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-II, Danapur, Patna in connection with G.R. No. 315 of 2019, arising out of Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 52 of 2019.
