ORAL ORDER

2 23-09-2019 Following is the grievance, which the petitioner has
raised in the present writ application:-

“1. That the present writ application is being filed in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondents specially Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to accept the joining of this petitioner on the post of Constable at Bhagalpur on the basis of the result published by Central Selection Board for selection of Constable, Patna on the basis of the result published and the petitioner whose Roll No. 6613100535 was declared successful and



gate pass was issued in favour of petitioner by the Central Selection Board, Patna after quashed the re-measurement happens on two various dates i.e., 14.7.2018 and 26.7.2018 have been conducted outside of guideline given in advertisement No. 01/17.”

2. Mr. N.K. Agarwal, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner appears to be correct in his submission that in similar circumstance, this Court by an order dated 30.07.2019 passed in CWJC No. 16522 of 2018 has disposed of a writ application filed by a similarly circumstanced person, asking the petitioner of the said case to appear before the Central Selection Board where her height would be re-verified and the decision taken by the Selection Board shall be treated to be the end of the matter and there would be no question for further re-measurement.

In terms of the said order of this Court dated 30.07.2019, passed in CWJC No. 16522 of 2018, this application is also disposed of.
