4 07-03-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No.417 of 2018,
registered for the offence punishable under Sections 120(B),
201, 302, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation has been made that the girl has
established relationship with Mukesh Sah and was staying in the
house of the petitioner, later on dead body of the girl was
recovered from the abundant field.

Looking to the nature of allegation, this Court is
not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail is rejected.



However, if the petitioner surrenders before the Court below within four weeks from today and prays for regular bail, the Court below will consider the same and pass appropriate order without being influenced by the order of this Court.
