ORAL ORDER

2 14-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 27.06.2018 in connection with Barun P.S. Case No.217 of 2018 registered for the offence under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the bail application was rejected by the court below only on the ground that he had only one criminal antecedent. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of the petitioner and he is merely the owner of the vehicle and the tempo was being run by the Driver and the Khalasi and he has no knowledge of any such recoveries.



Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances and the period of custody, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-VII Cum Special Judge (Excise), Aurangabad, in connection with Barun P.S. Case No.217 of 2018.
