Muffasil P.S. Case No. 278 of 2003 registered for the offences

punishable under Section 395 of the Indian Penal Code and

The case is based on the complaint petition and there

is allegation of committing dacoity and petitioner is named in

the FIR and case is of the year 2003 and impugned order shows

that non-bailable warrant has been issued against the petitioner

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is

circumstances, as stated above, I am not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail, rather petitioner to surrender and make prayer for regular bail, which shall be considered on its own merit, without being prejudiced by this Court.
