Barachatti P.S. Case No. 47 of 2017 registered for the offences

opium and police seized the same, which will appear from
seizure list.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is
that the land does not belong to the petitioner and he has falsely
been implicated on the basis of disclosure made by villagers.

Having heard both sides and in view of allegation, I
am not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the
petitioner, rather petitioner to surrender and make prayer for
regular bail, which will be considered on its own merit, without



being prejudiced by this order.

dismissed.
