3 25-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 22.07.2019 in connection with Kotwali P.S. Case No.335 of 2019 registered for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 385, 354(b), 504/506 of the I.P.C. and Section 37(2) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the only allegation against the petitioner is that he was found in a drunken state. It is further submitted that the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedents.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances and the petitioner has no criminal antecedents, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on his



furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise, Gaya, in connection with Kotwali P.S. Case No.335 of 2019.
