2 04-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 22.07.2019 in connection with Nanpur P.S. Case No.261 of 2019 registered for the offence under Sections 272, 273, 414 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30(a), 38 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of the petitioner and that he has got no criminal antecedents.

Considering the fact that the alleged recoveries were not from his conscious possession and that the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedents, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of



Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge-Cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Sitamarhi, in connection with Nanpur P.S. Case No.261 of 2019.
