learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are in custody since 18.07.2019 in connection with G.O. Case No.140 of 2019 registered for the offence under Sections 30(a) and 56(d) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of the petitioners, but they have been saddled on their shoulders. It is further submitted that the petitioners are having clean antecedents.

In view of the aforementioned facts and



circumstances, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.D.J.-II Cum Special Judge, Excise, Nawada, in connection with G.O. Case No.140 of 2019.
