the petitioner and learned AC to Government Advocate no.4.

The present petition has been filed for restoration of
C.W.J.C.No.15030 of 2011, which stood dismissed on
24.10.2016 due to non-prosecution. It is evident that on earlier
occasion also, the writ petition stood dismissed due to non-
prosecution. However, it was restored subsequently.

In the present petition, the reason has been assigned
