2 15-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 498(A)/323/34 of the Indian
Penal Code and 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

It appears that there is matrimonial dispute
between the parties and the earlier case was a divorce case filed
by the petitioner prior to the present criminal case. Petitioner is
husband of opposite party No.2. He is in custody since
02.07.2019. Investigation of the case is already complete.

Considering the chances of future settlement,
let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing



bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Nautan Police Station Case No.453 of 2018, subject to the condition that both bailors shall be resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below and further the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
