ORAL ORDER

2 23-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Suiya P.S. Case no. 48 of 2019, registered under Section 7
of the E.C. Act.

The accusation is that on 03.06.2019, Sri Guru
Rice Mill was searched from where 200 plastic bags of rice
were recovered, but plastic bags was of common use which
indicates about keeping of rice for black marketing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is the proprietor of Sri Guru Rice Mill from where
200 plastic bags rice were recovered. The seized rice was of his
rice mill, but the petitioner has been implicated on mere
suspicion. Moreover, storage of food grains has been



de-licensed in the year 2002.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the S.D.J.M. Banka in connection with Suiya P.S. Case No. 48 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
