learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are in custody since 12.08.2019 in connection with Case No.C2/494/19 registered for the offence under Section 30(A) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of the petitioners. The petitioners are also not having any criminal antecedents.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances and that the petitioners have no criminal



antecedents, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.D.J.-II-Cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Sitamarhi, in connection with Case No.C2/494/19.
