APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 341, 323, 504, & 387 of the Indian Penal Code and 27
of the Arms Act.

Allegedly, while the informant, after selling the sand was
returning his house, in the way, the petitioner is alleged to have
demanded ransom amount and on also, he assaulted the
informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there
is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the
petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 10-07-2019. Charge
sheet has already been submitted. There is land dispute between
the parties and for the said reason, this case has been instituted.



The allegation, made in the FIR is denied by the petitioner.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri B. N. Tripathi, learned Judicial Magistrate-Ist Class, Masaurhi in connection with Bhagwanganj P.S. Case No. 151 of 2018.
