ORAL ORDER

2 14-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are in custody since 31.07.2019 in connection with Bheja P.S. Case No.97 of 2019 (G.R. No.1346 of 2019) registered for the offence under Sections 272, 273, 34 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of the petitioners but from outside the house (*Gali*), which is running opposite the house of the petitioners. It is further submitted that these petitioners have got no criminal



antecedents.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge-Cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Madhubani, in connection with Bheja P.S. Case No.97 of 2019 (G.R. No.1346 of 2019).
