2 24-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 20/22 of N.D.P.S. Act.

The allegation is that 72 grams of ganja is
recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 8.7.2019. Charge sheet has
been submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering
of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. It is alleged that 72
grams of ganja is recovered. Same is below the commercial
quantity. Hence, Section 37 of N.D.P.S. Act is not applicable in
the present case. There is no compliance of Sections 42 and 50
of N.D.P.S. Act.



On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge (N.D.P.S. Act), Gaya in connection with N.D.P.S. case No.47 of 2019 arising out of Paraiya P.S. case No.93 of 2019.
