2 24-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 30.07.2019 in connection with Birpur P.S. Case No.107 of 2019 registered for the offence under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of the petitioner but from one Kanhaiya Singh, Mantosh Kumar Singh and others. The petitioner is not having any criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances and that the petitioner has no criminal antecedents, let the petitioner, above named, be released on



bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court of learned Sessions Judge-II Cum Special Judge, Excise Act, Begusarai, in connection Birpur P.S. Case No.107 of 2019.
