learned Counsel for the respondent State.

Against the notification dated 5.8.2014 awarding
punishment of dismissal, Counsel for the State submits that the
petitioner has remedy under Rule 24(2) of the Bihar CCA Rules,
2005, by filing a review in the form of memorial.

In view of such submission based on the Bihar CCA
Rules, 2005, this Court does not consider it proper to exercise
its discretion in favour of the petitioner at this stage when there
is adequate alternative remedy available under the Bihar CCA
Rules 2005.



Counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to avail of the remedy.

It is made clear that if the petitioner avails of the remedy under Rule 24(2) of the Bihar CCA Rules, 2005 within a period of eight weeks from today, the authorities shall consider the same in accordance with law without raising objection of the petitioner's application being filed by delay as the same is being relegated to the statutory alternative remedy on objection raised by Counsel for the State.

The writ application is disposed of.
