3      18-12-2019                      This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Pakridayal P.S. Case No. 4 of 2016, disclosing offences under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 307, 379, 448, 504, 506, 426 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.



Allegation against the petitioners is of assault to the son of informant.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioners is that no specific allegation has been attributed to the petitioner and injury is simple in nature.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, in view of the above facts, this application is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM-V, Motihari, East Champarna, in connection with Pakridayal P.S. Case No. 4 of 2016, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
