2 22-10-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in

connection with Bairiya P. S. Case No. 223 of 2019, disclosing

offence under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise

Act, 2016.

As per F.I.R. two persons were apprehended by the
police and there is recovery of liquor from the motorcycle.
Petitioner no.1 is owner of the motorcycle. Apart from that
petitioner is an accused in two other cases also.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is
that the villagers have taken the motorcycle on the plea of
purchasing the medicines and petitioner has no knowledge about
the same.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides, in view of the allegation and antecedent, I am not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, however, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned court below and make prayer for regular bail, the same shall be considered on its own merit.

With the aforesaid, this application is dismissed.
