2 14-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for
the offence under Sections 401, 413 and 414 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that the petitioner is innocent and has not
committed any offence. In fact, the co-accused having more
or less similar allegation has already been granted regular
bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in Cr. Misc. No. 7863
of 2019 and Cr. Misc. No. 9374 of 2019 and the case of this
petitioner stands of similar footing. The petitioner is rotting
in judicial custody since 02.07.2019. Hence, the petitioner



may be enlarged on regular bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the, above named, petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Pipra P.S. Case No. 261 of 2018.
