2 17-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the counsel appearing on behalf of the State as well as the Informant.

The petitioners are in custody in connection with Teghra P.S. Case No. 180 of 2019 for the offences under Sections 448, 341, 323, 504, 384, 385, 324, 326, 307, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is delay of two days in lodging F.I.R. and there is a case and counter case. Petitioners are in custody since 24.07.2019.

Considering the fact that there is delay of two days in
