Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 30.07.2019, in connection with Manjhgarrh P.S. Case No. 193 of 2019 for the offences under Sections 414, 420/34 of Indian Penal Code and 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged recoveries were not made from the conscious possession of the petitioner but from the vehicle which was allegedly being driven by one person who disclosed his name as Yogiraj @ Yogi Singh. It is further submitted that the petitioner is owner of neither the illegal liquor nor the vehicle from which it was recovered. The petitioner has got a clean antecedent.

Considering the aforementioned facts and



circumstances and that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional District Judge II cum Special Judge, Excise, Gopalganj, in connection with Manjhagarh P.S. Case No. 193 of 2019.
