Contempt Court and law laid down by the Apex Court in the

case of Union of India and Others Vs. Subedar Devassy PV,

reported in (2006) 1 SCC 613 reiterated in the case of Sudhir

Vasudeva, Chairman and MD, Natural Gas Corporation Limited

and Others Vs. M George Ravishekar and Others reported in

(2014) 3 SCC 373, the Court is not inclined to widen the scope

of contempt jurisdiction.

Accordingly, the contempt proceeding is dropped.



However, liberty shall be available to the petitioner, if he aggrieved by the decision taken by the opposite party vide Annexure-3, he may approach the appropriate forum/Court in accordance with law.

With the aforesaid liberty the present application stands disposed of.
