2 30-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal
Code with amended Sections 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Wife of this petitioner died unnatural death after about
7 years of her marriage and allegation is that she was poisoned
to death.

Submission is that there is no eyewitness of the
occurrence and after investigation of the case, the police
submitted charge-sheet under Section 306 of the Indian Penal
Code. In spite of the fact that there is no evidence that the
suicide was result of abetment caused by the petitioner.

Hence, let the petitioner, above named, be released on
bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty



Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Murliganj Police Station Case No. 203 of 2019, subject to the following conditions:-

(a) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the learned court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(b) Both the bailors shall be resident of the territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.
