learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are in custody since 30.07.2019 in connection with Nadi P.S. Case No. 35 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 420/467/468/34 of the IPC and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of the petitioners rather from one Navin Kumar. It is further submitted that the petitioners have no criminal antecedents.



In view of the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioners above named be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, West Champaran, Bettiah, in connection with Nadi P.S. Case No. 35 of 2018.
