2 15-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 392, 120B of the Indian Penal Code and later on Sections 395 and 397 I.P.C. has been added.

The FIR of the occurrence of dacoity is against unknown. Name of the petitioner surfaced in the confessional statement of co-accused.

Submission is that petitioner is in custody since 30.05.2019. He was never put on T.I. Parade during investigation nor any incriminating article was recovered from his possession. Investigation of the case is already complete.

Considering the facts aforesaid, let the



petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Mehshi Police Station Case No.451 of 2018, subject to the condition that both bailors shall be resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below and further the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
