The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under Section
25(1-b)a/26/35 of the Arms Act.

Allegedly, two pistols are recovered in this case.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there
is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the
petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 25-02-2019. Charge
sheet has already been submitted. Two pistols are alleged to
have been recovered. There is no compliance of Section 100
Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is
named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let



the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing
bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of

Chief Judicial Magistrate-VII, Aurangabad in connection with
Kutumba P.S. Case No. 27 of 2019.
