counsel for the State and learned counsel for the informant.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Makhdumpur (Tehta O.P.) P.S. Case No.274 of 2019 registered
under Sections 302 and 120B read with 34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Considering that the deceased died on 02.12.2018
for which a U.D. Case was registered on the statement of the
brother-in-law of the deceased vide U.D. Case No.13 of 2018 on
02.12.2018 itself and the first information report of the instant
case has been registered against the petitioner and others after
lapse of six months on 18.06.2019, the prayer is allowed. The
petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail
bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand only) with two



sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sub
Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Jehanabad in connection with
Makhdumpur (Tehta O.P.) P.S. Case No.274 of 2019.
